## **WRW Treasurer's Report**

The routine Club income and expenses have remained fairly consistent with those from 2023.

This year we have been working with Emily Daly to help with raising the profile of the Club in a bid to attract more members. This process is still on-going but the new look website and logo is up and running and is looking good.

Our expenses were up again this year, the deficit for the year has again been mostly offset by the term deposit interest rates, which may not be so favourable moving into 2025.

While we have posted a loss for the year we are still in a sound financial position due to the funds from previous years, but will continue to eat into these funds without the input of new members and greater income from subscriptions.

## **Member Subscriptions**

I recommend that the members' subscription for 2025 increase to \$50 with a discount of \$10 if paid by 28 February 2025.
