

WRW Treasurer's Report 2025

Over the past year the Club has focused on the fundamentals—our regular runs and walks from Ākau Tangi Sports Centre (ĀTSC), outings to Otari Bush, the bus trips, and our annual Club dinner.

We are pleased to report that the financial loss for this year is smaller than in previous years. This improvement is due to favourable interest rates on our term deposits, one fewer bus trip, and completing our own marketing following Emily Daly's departure.

This year we booked the ĀTSC room for 3¼ hours each Sunday. We acknowledge Holly for managing the bags left in her care and preparing raro and biscuits for members finishing their run at ĀTSC. Our walking group has continued to enjoy their post-walk coffees at Park Kitchen in Miramar.

After review, the Committee decided that hiring the room for several hours each week is not the best use of Club funds, given the small number of bags requiring supervision. From next year, the room will be booked for one hour—sufficient time to gather, share notices, provide route information, and depart. Members can use the coin-operated lockers in the foyer to secure their bags or leave them in their vehicles.
